Dear Mr. Fleming,

On March 11, 2015 members of the Northeast Energy Direct project team met with you to review protocols for setting survey control points within public ways. At that time you suggested the following:

- "Men Working" flagging be used on all town roads whenever surveyors are parked on the road.
- Police details be used on all County and State Roads.
- The Town Administrators office, Police Department and Town DPW Superintendent Fred McCagg (518)766-9417 be notified daily while survey crews are doing any work on roads within the Town.
- If any heavy equipment is used on a Town road, then a permit with bond will be required.

Subsequently our survey coordinator spoke with the local police, State Troop G and the Rensselaer County Sheriff Department regarding arrangement of a police detail for County and State Roads. All parties contacted indicated if we were not closing a lane in the roadway, then no police officer would be necessary.

Tennessee Gas Pipeline Company will implement your requirements for all town roads, yet for the county and state roads, no police detail will be used unless a lane of traffic is closed.
